After School/In School Good News Club FAQs

1. What are After School/In School Good News Clubs?

These are classes held by Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) of Wyoming & Sullivan Counties. The children enrolled attend the class or “club” after school, in the school building. The Good News Club (GNC) lasts approximately one hour and thirty minutes, one day per week. GNC is not held on days when there is no school.

2. What takes place in these After School/In School Clubs?

The children sing songs and choruses, learn a Bible memory verse, hear a continuing missionary story, and a Bible lesson. There are games and other activities, too.

3. Is there a fee for participating?

There is **NO COST** or expense to the children for participating. No public fees are used. CEF is a non-profit organization supported by individual donors and churches. We are inter-denominational and independent of other religious affiliations. Our State Headquarters is located in Harrisburg at 4305 Winthrop Drive. Information can also be found online at cefepa.net. As a part of our club program we support missionaries around the world from various missions’ organizations, and a free-will offering is taken for these missionaries. However, the children at **NO TIME** are under any obligation to give to CEF for any of these missionaries.

4. How do parents enroll their children in these classes?

Parents may use the permission slip provided to inform the school and CEF that they wish to enroll their child(ren). These permission slips are provided by CEF and are distributed to the students of the schools where the clubs are being held.

5. Where are the clubs held?

The clubs are held in various areas of the schools. We have been graciously allowed to use libraries, cafeterias, all-purpose rooms, or wherever the school allows us. The School District itself does not sponsor or endorse these clubs, but allow access to their facilities, under the equal access law.

6. When are clubs held?

GNC usually begin in October and run through the end of April. Clubs are held immediately after school dismisses.

7. Which grades are involved?

We offer GNC to all children in the school in which clubs are being held.

Parents are responsible to pick up children at the end of club and to provide transportation home. CEF cannot provide transportation. Club will not be held on days school is not in session, dismisses early- for any reason, or if afternoon activities are cancelled- for any reason.
